

PILOT MUNICIPALITIES FOR INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

GEOGRAPHICAL LOCATION, HISTORY AND CHARACTERISTICS

Mustafakemalpaşa, with its 102.000 population (54.029 is served by the municipality), is a district of Bursa which is an important city in the Marmara Region. Bursa was one of the first capital cities of Ottoman Empire. Named after Mustafa Kemal Atatürk, the founder of modern Turkish Republic, Mustafakemalpaşa has a history of 2500 years of settlement. The district, which is rich in historical and archaeological heritage, is also famous with its well-known dessert called "Mustafakemalpaşa sweet". Natural beauties such as waterfalls, spas, caves, creeks, green fields make the district attractive for nature and culture tourism.



ECONOMIC SITUATION

Agriculture and husbandry are the leading sources of income and agricultural industry is developing rapidly. One of the most prominent tomato processing plant in Turkey is located in Mustafakemalpaşa. Local economy also enjoys fresh water fishery and the district is rich with marble quarries, lignite, boron and kaoline. The organized industrial site of the district houses 10 factories, manufacturing machinery, textile, wood work and plastic ware.



MUNICIPAL SERVICES

Municipality of Mustafakemalpaşa is responsible for serving citizens to meet their demands, especially in the fields of infrastructure, and social and public services.
